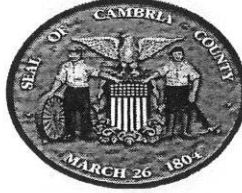

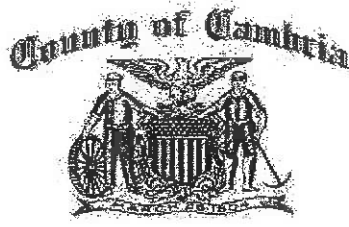

PERSONNEL:

Thomas Hagerman – remove from full time Corrections Officer I effective January 12th.

OPERATIONS:

MAJOR MAINTENANCE / FACILITIES UPDATES:

Kronos Time Keeping Software – Still testing software. Anticipated go-live date is still February.
Hot Water Tank – the new tank was installed on Wednesday, Dec. 13th. Remove from agenda.
Vehicle Sallyport Drain – The drainage trench in the vehicle sallyport is showing significant corrosion of the metal trench and failure of the concrete surrounding it. Our maintenance department is currently exploring repair options and we will provide an update next month.

POSSIBLE SOLAR PROJECT

Last month I informed the board that we are exploring the possibility of a solar array on the roof and prison hillside to help offset electricity costs. The BAI Group and Tremco have completed their analysis and have reached out to schedule a follow up meeting with us on Wednesday, January 17th. The meeting will be at 10am at the prison if any board members are interested in attending.

BOIL WATER NOTICE

When the Ebensburg area was placed on a boil notice last week, we were able to work with EMA Director Art Martinuska to secure both potable and non-potable water to use throughout the water emergency. We would like to once again thank Art for his quick response.

DOC INSPECTION

We have received notification that our annual Department of Corrections facility inspection will be held on April 4th. We have already begun preparations of the facility and review/collection of the necessary documentation.

PA SAVIN

Our agreement with PA Savin, the electronic victim notification software that we utilize at the prison, has been renewed for 2024 with The Pennsylvania District Attorney's Institute paying for all of the software agreement and maintenance fees. The county has a 0% cost for the software. This is the 4th or 5th year running that PDAI has covered the costs.

INTERVIEWS/ACADEMY

Currently we are 10 full time officers short. In addition, we have been informed of four additional staff members who have interviewed/or are scheduled for interviews at FCI Loretto. We will be scheduling interviews throughout the remainder of January with a new cadet academy slated to begin February 19th.
