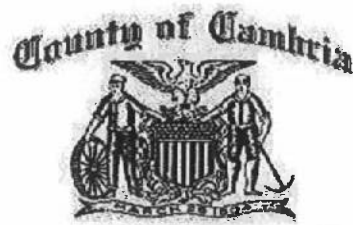

MAJOR MAINTENANCE / FACILITIES UPDATES:

Kronos Time Keeping Software – Update: Still building and testing the software. Due to some issues and changes with the program build, Kronos has not implemented the software yet.

Air Purification System – No further update since last month. Waiting on direction from the Commissioner's office.

Solar Project – No further update from last month. Waiting on direction from the Commissioner's office.

ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE PRISON'S INMATE HANDBOOK

The inmate Handbook was reviewed and revised. A digital copy was placed onto the inmate's tablets and they must acknowledge at sign on that they received it. Hardcopies will only be given to new commitments who don't yet have a tablet issued.

RECRUITMENT SEMINAR

Our Director of Training and Recruitment, Jessica Greathouse, attended a two day seminar in Pittsburgh titled "Recruiting and Retaining the Next Generation". This seminar was offered by the Municipal Police Officer's Education and Training Commission and focused specifically on the recruitment and retention in law enforcement professions. Upon her return, our admin team met with her to discuss the seminar and what she could implement with our recruiting procedures.

OFFENDER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

The week of 3/12, we had our Offender Management Software updated to the newest version available. This was done at no cost due through our current agreement with Viapath/GTL. Although there were some issues with the install, the majority of them have been resolved. There is still currently one outstanding issue with crediting inmate's accounts for damaged or returned commissary items. Viapath/GTL is currently working on a solution or work-around to this issue.

RADIOS

The prison was converted over to the new digital radio system for 911. We were issued a total of 21 handheld radios, 10 vehicle radios, and 3 base stations placed at strategic locations throughout the prison. 9 additional handhelds are still on order. We now have 2 separate radio systems operating at the facility. Our old frequency and radios are still used for in-house communications, while the new digital one is used for communications outside of the facility and with the 911 center.

PEPPERBALL RIFLE INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Last month, we hosted a two day Pepperball Rifle Instructor Course presented by United Tactical Systems, LLC. We had approximately 20 attendees from across PA and neighboring states attend the course. As a benefit of hosting, we received two free attendees to the course.

DOC INSPECTION

Our Department of Corrections inspection is scheduled for April 25th. We have been spending most of the last month working on collecting/preparing/submitting all required documentation and ensuring the facility is up to par with requirements. I would like to thank Deputy Descavish for taking the lead on this very daunting task.

During the month of March we continued working on basic food service practices and training with the inmate work force. We also started training on proper storage practices in the food industry, such as proper storage of dry goods, fresh and frozen products as well as cleaning supplies. We went over the FIFO (First In First Out) system of rotation as well.

MONTHLY COST PER MEALS

The cost per meal for the month of March was \$1.4744 for a total food cost of \$54,400.27. This was an increase of \$0.0081 from the month of February.

UP-COMING MONTHS

During the month of April they will continue working on basic food service practices and training inmate workers in the day to day work duties as well as training with person hygiene and its importance in the work place.

I will also continue working with Joe Medvan from the Nutrition Group on ways to try and help with rising food costs and shortages.
