Public Comment:

John DeBartola stated that he does not agree with the \$15.00 fee being reinstated for blighted property. He doesn't feel that the County is making a dent in the amount of blighted properties, and this is ultimately a tax. He also stated that he submitted a Right to Know Request for the amount of money being spent at the new Day Reporting Center, as it seems the County bought a building and did not have a proper inspection done. He is also hearing that the Courthouse is in need of a new roof.
